- 5. Bro. William Perry presented the Diplomas and Bro. Ronnie McCarney presented Lodge Aprons.
- 6. Balance Sheet. W.M. presented the Balance Sheet which had been circulated to all members prior to the meeting. The Funds of the Lodge were very healthy and the Accounts were unanimously adopted.
